Third Grade Reading Correlates with High School Graduation Rates



- A child's reading proficiency by third grade has a direct correlation to their success in high school and beyond.
- Students who don't read proficiently by third grade are four times more likely to leave high school without a diploma than proficient readers.
- Young children whose parents read them five books a day enter kindergarten having heard about 1.4 million more words than kids who were never read to, a new study found.



Children bring home a Red Book Bag weekly or every other week filled with award-winning books to practice the habit of sharing books.









